

Key Dates Relevant to Phoebe Randall 1822 - 1910

and Phoebe Randall 1802 - 1852; see end of document

This *lit'l ol' mawther fr'm Cley* crops up for the first time in the Minutes of the 20th of January 1840 and comes across as a simple and hapless victim of the times. She survived though, and enjoyed a long and relatively comfortable life.

To be read in conjunction with the Minutes of Meetings of the Erpingham Poor Law Guardians dated:

1792 - Phoebe's Mother Elizabeth NEWTON was born 9 Jun 1791 at Great Snoring, daughter of John & Margaret (nee DEATH).

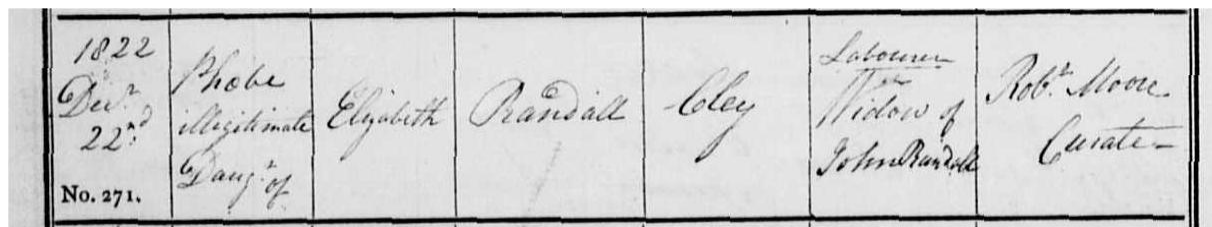
1818 - John RANDALL and Elizabeth NEWTON were married at Cley St. Margaret on 13 Jan 1819; both single. Witnesses Pamela RANDALL and Robert MATTHEWS.

1818 - Phoebe's sister Naomi RANDALL was baptised at Cley 20 Oct 1818; daughter of John RANDALL, Mariner, & Elizabeth nee NEWTON.

1820 - Phoebe's brother Richard RANDALL was baptised 16 Aug 1820; son of John RANDALL, Mariner, & Elizabeth NEWTON.

1821 approx. - John RANDALL died; not found in records, so perhaps at sea.

1822 - Phoebe RANDALL was baptised at Cley 22 Dec 1822. When she married in 1853 she gave her Father's name as William BELL (believed to be a banker¹ and/or mariner b. 1806 Cley - not found in 1841 but appears at Yarmouth 1851).



1825 - Elizabeth RANDALL, widow of Little Walsingham, married Henry GOGLE, widower of Cley, at Cley on 16th March.

1840 - Phoebe's first child Mary Anne was born and was baptised at Southrepps St. James on 30 Aug 1840.

1841 - Census. Phoebe, age 19, and daughter Maryann, age 1, were living in Cley with carpenter James Cawston (age 77), his wife Sarah and their daughter Rebecca.

1841 - Another Phoebe RANDALL age 35 (see Phoebe (2) notes at the end of this document) is listed in the return for Sheringham Workhouse. She was born at Sheringham and has no connection with Phoebe of Cley.

1842/43 - Phoebe's second child would have been born. No record found as yet; perhaps still-born.

¹ One of a team of labourers who maintained the Cley sea defences (similar to dykes).

1845 - A Phoebe Randall - (1) or (2)? - was ordered to be moved from Sheringham Workhouse to Gimingham on 19 May.

1845 - A Phoebe Randall - (1) or (2)? - was ordered to be moved from Gimingham Workhouse to Sheringham on 20 October.

1846 - Henry GOGLE was buried at Cley on 1 Oct 1846; age 75.

1847 - 'Resolved That Mr. George Rix, Master of the Gimingham Workhouse, do prefer a Bill of Indictment (at the next General Quarter Session of the Peace for the County of Norfolk to be holden at the Castle of Norwich in the Shirehouse there on Wednesday the Seventeenth day of March One thousand eight hundred and Forty seven) against Phoebe Randall and Mary Ann Atkins, late Inmates of the Gimingham Workhouse, for Stealing, taking and carrying away from the same House One bed rug, One Blanket, One Sheet and One Girl's Shift, the property of the Board of Guardians of the Erpingham Union' (Minutes 8 March 1847).

1847 - Phoebe RANDALL age 24 (b. approx 1823) was imprisoned 1 month for Larceny at the Norwich County Sessions on 17 Mar 1847. Mary Ann ATKINS, age 22, received 2 months.

1848 - Death of daughter Mary Ann RANDLE: Erpingham Mar 1848 13 72

1851 - Cley Census: Elizabeth GOGLE, Innkeeper age 59 born Great Snoring. With Daughter Mary age 23 born Cley.

1851 - Southrepps Census, Lower Street. Mary A. BLOOM unmarried Pauper age 51 born Southrepps. Phoebe RANDLE, unmarried Nurse, age 26, born Cley. She was actually 28.

1853 - Phoebe RANDAL married Jonathan BROWNE, widowed shoemaker, at Hempstead All Saints on 30 Jan 1853. Her father's name was given as William BELL, banker. Witnesses were Robert TUNNER and Lydia BROWNE. Registration Erpingham Mar 1853 4b 81.

1854 - John GOGLE took over the Three Swallows Inn.

1860 - Elizabeth GOGLE buried 16th May 1862 at Cley, age 72.

1861 - Hempstead Census. Jonathan BROWN Shoemaker age 59 born Bodham. Wife Phebe age 41 born Cley.

1871 - Hempstead Census, Holt Road. Jonathan BROWN Shoemaker age 70 born Cley. Wife Phoebe age 51 born Bodham.

1881 - Hempstead Census, Holt Road. Jonathan BROWNE Shoemaker age 80 born Bodham. Wife Phoebe age 63 born Cley.

1891 - Hempstead Census, Holt Road. Phoebe BROWN Widow age 70 born Cley. 3 rooms.

1901 - Holt Census. Loynes Yard. Phoebe BROWN Widow age 82 born Cley. 2 rooms.

1910 - Death of Phoebe age 90: Erpingham 1910 Mar 4b 44.



1802 - **Phoebe (2)** RANDALL baptised at Sheringham on 19 Feb 1802; d. of Clement & Sarah

1841 - Sheringham Workhouse, Census: **Phoebe (2)** RANDALL age 35, Pauper Y

1841 - Sheringham Workhouse 2 Oct 1841: **Phoebe (2)** RANDALL 38 Do. Lame.

1851 - West Beckham Workhouse Census: **Phoebe (2)** RANDLE age 47 (b. 1804) Pauper, former Servant, born Sheringham.

1852 - Death of **Phoebe (2)** RANDALL; Erpingham Jun 1852 4b 41.
