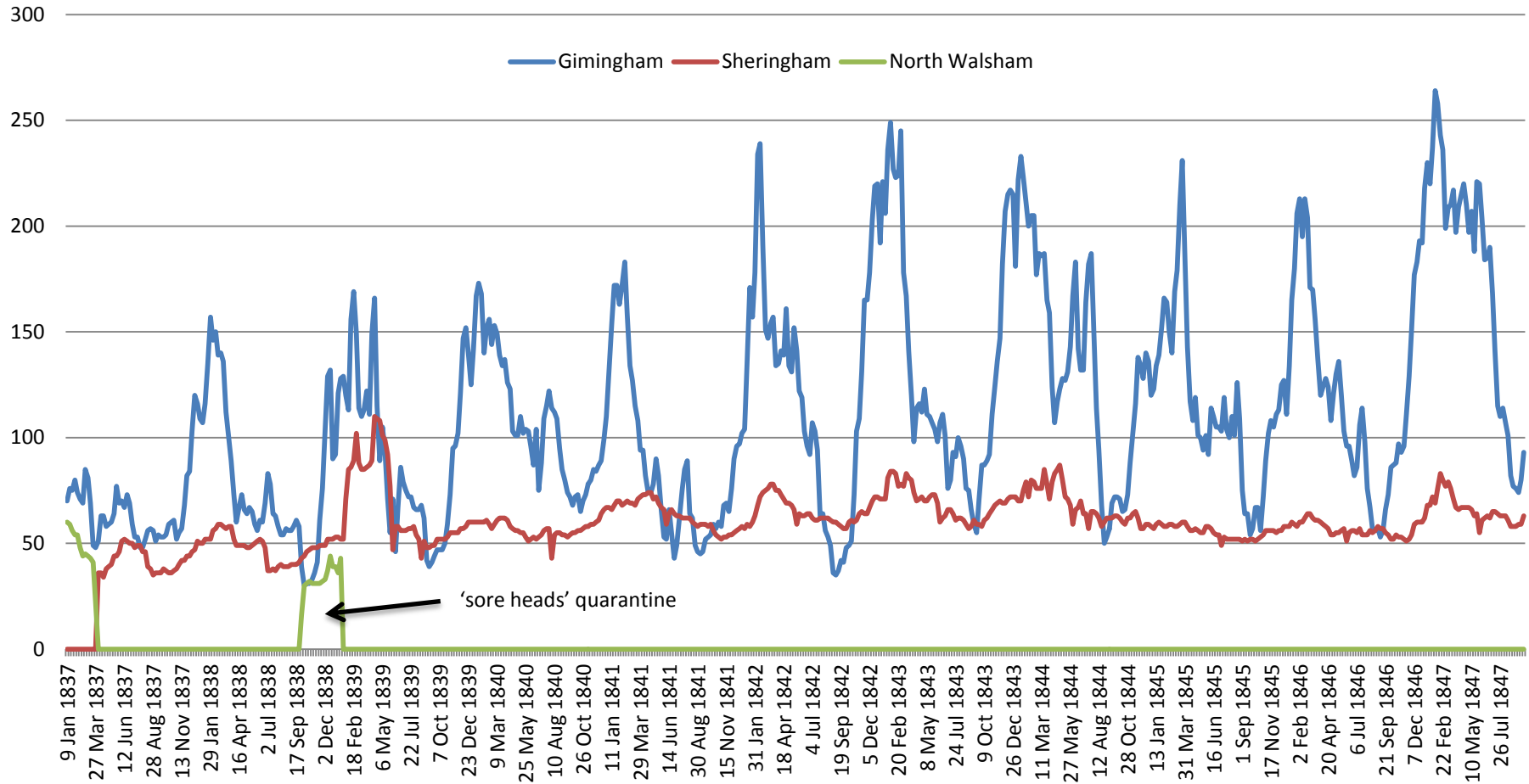


# Occupancy of Workhouses



The annual cycles show peaks in the winter months and troughs at the time of harvest. Sheringham has much smaller variations because the inmates were predominantly the old and/or infirm, who were in residence throughout the year, whereas the Gimmingham House had a largely able-bodied population. Figures were not included in the Minutes after the middle of 1847.
