Mott, John Thruston, Esquire	Barningham Hall	JP, DL and High Sheriff of Norfolk 1808.	12 April 1836	Born on 17 Nov 1784. Married Sophia Partridge on 11 Apr 1808. Gentleman Commoner of Magdalen College. Served in 1st Eastern Regiment of Local Militia. Resigned Chairmanship of the Board in October 1844 through 'severe indisposition' and received profuse thanks for his service. Died 12 Sep 1847.
Gunton, Dennis, Esquire	Matlask Hall	JP	12 April 1836	There were 2 Dennis Guntons (1) b. 1767 approx., bur. 19 Mar 1842 age 75, (2) bap. 6 Nov 1804 & bur. 22 Oct 1848 age 43.
Glover, George, The Venerable Archdeacon	Southrepps	Commissary of Norfolk	12 April 1836	Born approx 1788 Vicar of Cromer approx. 1805. Vicar of Gayton. Archdeacon of Sudbury 1823 - 1862 and Rector of South Repps (lived at the Vicarage). Died 4th May 1862 at Southrepps. Wife Charlotte.
Girdlestone, William Ewin, The Reverend	Kelling Rectory	JP	12 April 1836	b. Kelling 1 Nov 1786, bur. Kelling 13 Jan 1840. Ordained 1814. Stipendary Curate of Stoke Ferry & Boughton. Rector of Kelling with Salthouse 1821.
Flavell/Flavill, Josiah Webb, The Reverend	Norwich Road, Holt	Magistrate	12 April 1836	Born 1773 at Harlaston, Staffordshire. Principal landowner of Holt. Rector of Stody with Hunworth 1801-1848. Married Caroline Aufrere of Hoveton Hall 1802. Died 1848 at Holt.
Gay, John Johnson, Esquire	Alborough (New) Hall	Magistrate, JP & DL	12 April 1836	A great part of the soil <of Alborough> belongs to J.J. Gay, Esq., who has been a magistrate forty years, and resides at the New Hall, a handsome mansion in a well-wooded lawn, erected in 1636, and enlarged in 1818. The manor of Aldborough was long held by the De Herewards, and was carried in marriage by the heiress of T. Parker, Esq., to the Gays, about the close of the 16th century.' - White's 1845. Moved to Boulogne.
Upcher, Henry Ramey, Esquire	Sheringham Hall	JP & DL	4 July 1836	Born 1810 at Kirby Cane. Trinity College, Cambridge, B.A. 1832, M.A. 1835. Died 1892 at Sheringham.
Suffield, The Right Honorable Lord	Gunton Hall	Member of the Privy Council.	26 September 1836	Edward Vernon Harbord, 4th Baron Suffield was born on 19 June 1813. Christ Church, Oxford. He married Charlotte Susannah Gardner, daughter of Admiral Alan Hyde Gardner, 2nd Baron Gardner of Uttoxeter and Hon. Charlotte Elizabeth Smith, on 1 September 1835. He died on 22 August 1853 at age 40. He was the son of Edward Harbord, 3rd Baron Suffield and Georgiana Vernon. He gained the title of 4th Baron Suffield. 'Erected a handsome hall at Horstead.' A Liberal.
Hardy, William Hardy Cozens	Letheringsett Hall	Magistrate	20 May 1839	See list of Guardians.
Wilkinson, W.F. (or W.J. ?), The Reverend	North Walsham Vicarage	Landowner & Vicar of St. Nicholas'	20 April 1836	Only appeared once.
Holley, James Hunt	Burgh Hall (+ Oaklands, Devon)	JP	11 May 1846	Born 1804 at Blickling. Lord of the Manor of Burgh. Married Horatia Windham (b. Felbrigg) 1832. 1851 - Burgh. Magistrate, Agriculturalist farming 800 acres & employing 25 labourers. His brother Edward was Rector of Burgh. Died 1892 in Devon.
Pemberton, Walter Hamilton	Holt Hall	JP	24 Apr 1848	Born 1807 in London. White's 1845 directory for Holt: '... has a handsome mansion, lately built, in the Tudor style' (Holt Hall). 1851 - Justice of the Peace, Fund holder & Landowner occupying 273 acres of arable & pasture land, 121 wood & 40 heath. Died 1894 at Denton.
